Closed until further notice:

- Summersville Arena and Conference Center with the following events cancelled:
 - Experience the Ultimate Women's Day
 - West Virginia Woods and Water Expo
 - Citizens Police Academy
 - City Easter Egg Hunt.

It is important to understand the threat is still low and the impact to the majority of people will be minor. The serious threat lies with our elderly population and those with compromised health conditions.
